After an Indian lunch, proceed to the Yonghe Lamasery - the centre of Lama Administration. Also, go to visit pearl factory to enjoy pearl history in china, where they also teach you how to distinguish real pearl from fake pearl. Later, visit the Temple Of Heaven - China's largest existing complex of ancient sacrificial buildings.



It is considered as one of the most beautiful buildings in the world. Walk down the famous Hutongs the narrow lanes and alleys, characteristic of the city (if time permits). Tonight enjoy an Indian dinner.

Overnight at Hotel Xinyuan or similar in Beijing.(B, L, D)

DAY 03

Visit the Great Wall one of the greatest wonders. Visit the Summer Palace the Garden of Natural Harmony.

After a buffet breakfast at the hotel, proceed for an excursion to the Great Wall of China. Walk on this mammoth structure that is visible from outer space.

After a local Lunch, visit the Summer Palace and see the second home of the Imperial Court, with its huge collection of over 1,000 paintings, charming gardens with marble pagodas and delicately arched bridges. Tonight enjoy an Indian dinner.

Fly to Xi'an. Visit the Terra Cotta Army Museum the most significant archeological excavations of the 20th century. See The Tang Dynasty Music and Dance Show.

After a buffet breakfast at the hotel, check out and proceed to



the airport for your flight to Xi'an - the ancient capital city of 11 dynasties. Today, enjoy a local lunch. Later today, proceed to the Terra Cotta Army Museum that showcases the 2200-year old coloured terra-cotta army of more than 8000 soldiers and horses that guard the tomb of China's first emperor-Qinshihuang. Tonight see The Tang Dynasty Music and Dance Show, a wonderful performance of ancient music and dance.

Tonight enjoy an Indian dinner.

Overnight at Hotel Wannian or similar in Xi'an.(B, L, D)

DAY 05

Visit Wild Goose Pagoda and Ancient City Hall. Fly to Chongqing and board the Victoria Star Cruise.

After a buffet breakfast at the hotel, check out and visit the Wild Goose Pagoda the symbol of the old line Xian, a well-preserved ancient building and a holy place for Buddhists. Visit the ancient city wall - the most complete city wall that has survived in China, as well being one of the largest ancient military defensive systems in the world.
